

ECHINACEA 'French Tips' A large shell pink coneflower that transitions to white at the tips of its petals.

Full Sun · 20-24" · Zone 4-9 · PPAF



ERYNGIUM 'Lapis Blue'

Smokey blue color runs from the thistle-like top down the stems and into the deeply serrated leaves. Part-Full Sun  $\cdot$  22-26"  $\cdot$  Zone 5-9



# ERYNGIUM Native of Note yuccafolium

Gold standard for support for a wide range of pollinators native to North America, very ornamental with white balls over yucca-style leaves. *Full Sun · 3-4' · Zone 3-8* 



Outstanding bronze leaves with heavy white frosting and pinks along the margins. Red ox-eye in flower center bleeds out to orange tips. *Part-Full Sun* · 24-32" · Zone 5-9 · PPAF

### PULMONARIA 'NOVA Cobalt'

Saturated blue flowers over spotted leaves. Vigorous wide habit that knits togther to form a bed. *Full Sun · 12-14" · Zone 4-9 · PPAF* 



### HELLEBORUS Sparkle series

The first drama queen to bloom in the early spring garden, Winter Sparkle Hellebores display color from about late February into early April. Flowers face upwards with bright colors and thick petals. They hold up well against winter snows and ice, and equally thick leaves keep the plant evergreen in most of the continental United States. Part-Full Shade • 12-18" • Zone 4-9 • PPAF
